#### **FAI CIAM News**

A draft proposal is in the process of being submitted to FAI CIAM by UK to re-word the F3K rule regarding what constitutes a valid landing. If accepted, this will remove ambiguity regarding what happens when/if a model lands just outside the start/landing box but can still be reached by the pilot. The new re-wording should also clarify that a pilot who attempts to catch a model, which then actually lands outside the start/landing box is not considered a valid landing.

If accepted by CIAM, this should be effective for next years' flying season. Following discussion with the German FAI representative, Germany has also indicated support for this rule change/clarification.

### **UK BMFA F3K league**

After a lot of healthy debate and hard work, a series of documents have now been submitted to the BMFA SFTC (silent flight tech committee) to enable

- a new BMFA F3K rulebook section to be published, as part of the upcoming BMFA 2008 rule book.
- BMFA F3K league proposal
- BMFA F3K league 2008 contest calendar.

The end result of this should be, following SFTC review and approval, that a new BMFA F3K league is run in 2008.

As well as forming the basis of an exciting new UK F3K contest calendar for 2008, it will also form the basis for a formal UK F3K team selection process, so that (pending contest announcements) we have a UK F3K team ready for any international events in 2009. With F3K becoming a formal FAI class next year, with the new BMFA league framework being implemented and UK F3K team places up for grabs, it looks like 2008 will be an exciting one for F3K in UK.

We would like to encourage participation in the new league by all UK F3K pilots, both old and new. So if you haven't yet participated in a F3K contest, please do come along and join in, a warm friendly welcome awaits.

This new BMFA F3K league will be run year on year, with a new UK F3K team selected at the end of each calendar year. You will be able to see the BMFA rules and basis for the league and team selection in the 2008 BMFA rules handbook when published in early 2008.

It is probable that other F3K events will also be held in UK in 2008, in addition to the BMFA league events, although they will form no part of the BMFA league and results. Although the league will form the basis of much of the 2008 UK contest calendar in UK, it should not preclude any additional UK F3K events being held, as events in their own right (eq. F3K events held at short notice, to take advantage of good weather etc)

A draft BMFA F3K league contest calendar for 2008 is being reviewed by SFTC. We have tried to avoid clashes with known major international F3K events wherever possible, but pending approval, currently is;
